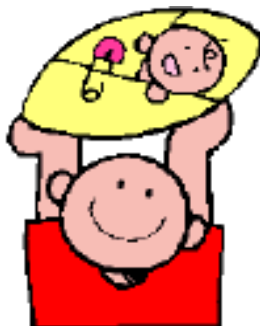

The high cost of baby formula or delays in availability of formula from federally-funded infant nutrition programs may cause a struggling mother to feed her hungry newborn fruit juices or other inappropriate foods.

The most often requested baby formula is Similac Advance. We do accept all types of formula. We distribute the baby formula to food cupboards, Catholic Social Services, and other organizations that partner with us in helping the most vulnerable among us.
